WOOD MOLDINGS – INSTALLATION

INSTALLATION METHODS

For many projects, our wood moldings can be simply glued onto your woodwork. In situations where the wood is unfinished, good quality Carpenters glue can be used. For situations where the wood is already finished (or even in cases of unfinished wood), we would recommend a panel or caulking adhesive such as Liquid Nails or DAP Kwik Seal Caulking Adhesive. Being a water based product, Kwik Seal is particularly easy to clean up – excess glue can be peeled away and any remaining residue wiped away with water.

- Our wood moldings can be installed using screws, nails, and a strong wood adhesive.
- Please consult your local hardware store for recommended wood adhesives.

FINISHING INFORMATION

- Our wood moldings are both stain-grade and paint-grade. Please follow the paint manufacturer's instructions on proper finishing techniques.
